INSURANCE PROVIDERS FOR MEDICAID

DBH is the insurance provider for Medicaid. Children & Youth outpatient services focus primarily on the child and family. Outpatient therapy is provided by licensed clinicians. Treatment is provided in the community, clinic, home or school.

MEDICAL EVALUATION AND MANAGEMENT

DBH can provide medical evaluations and management. There is a psychiatrist, an APRN and medical assistants in the clinic.

CASE MANAGEMENT

DBH will provide assessments and link families to community resources.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT SPECIALISTS

DBH has youth advocates to provide mentoring and teach positive social skills by taking youth on activities and practicing appropriate behavior.

QUEST PROGRAM
